Postdoc "Social tipping points and the climate challenge" University of Bern, Switzerland

(80-100%, 2 years plus 1-year extension)

Tipping points in both natural and social systems are getting increasing attention in the face of the climate challenge. However, climate and social tipping points tend to be treated in a similar way and with similar tools despite fundamental differences, raising a number of epistemic and methodological issues. This interdisciplinary research project will investigate the extent to which a meaningful and operational notion of social tipping point can be articulated and applied to concrete case studies. The first (conceptual) part will critically examine the various ways in which the concept of social tipping point is articulated in relation to the climate challenge. In the second (operational) part, the aim is to identify potentially new cases of social tipping points, focusing in particular on the extent to which they can be predicted and intervened on (triggered). The Postdoc will be co-supervised by Prof. Dr. Vincent Lam (Institute of Philosophy, https://philoclimate.ch) and Prof. Dr. Isabelle Stadelmann-Steffen (Institute of Political Science).

Profile of the candidate

The successful candidate holds a PhD in Philosophy of Science or Political/Social Sciences or Climate Science with demonstrated interests in Philosophy of Science and Political/Social Sciences dimensions. The candidate will have strong capacities for interdisciplinary research and for working in an interdisciplinary environment. Fluency in English is required, both written and spoken.
